ed.Details reveal that the college has been approved for 63 seats in its first year, which includes reservations for economically weaker sections. Fifteen percent of the seats will be filled through the central pool, while the Jammu and Kashmir Board of Professional Entrance Examination (JKBOPEE) will handle the selection for the remaining seats.
