

PSG And Chelsea Set For Club World Cup Final Showdown

The curtain comes down on the first edition of FIFA's expanded Club World Cup when reigning European champions Paris Saint-Germain face Chelsea in Sunday's final at the MetLife Stadium, with Donald Trump among those set to be in attendance. It is the kind of glamour match-up that FIFA president Gianni Infantino would have been hoping for to wrap up the tournament, which on Saturday he labelled as marking the start of "the golden era of club football".

Chelsea coach Enzo Maresca acknowledged ahead of the game that PSG are "probably in this moment the best team in the world", and the French side are hoping to cap off the most remarkable of seasons by completing a stunning clean sweep of trophies.

PSG won a French league and cup double before claiming the UEFA Champions League for the first time in their history with a record-breaking 5-0 victory over Inter Milan in the final at the end of May.

Luis Enrique's side have carried that form over into



the Club World Cup, putting four goals past Atletico Madrid in the group stage and four more past Lionel Messi's Inter Miami before defeating Bayern Munich in the quarter-finals.

They then produced a masterclass in a 4-0 thrashing of Real Madrid in the semi-finals on Wednesday.

It would be a shock if

Chelsea claimed the trophy against a PSG side led by Ballon d'Or candidate Ousmane Dembele.

However, the Stamford Bridge side came to the United States fresh from finishing fourth in the Premier League and winning the UEFA Conference League.

"They are one of the hottest teams in the world at the moment but this is the final, a one-off game," said Chelsea's Reece James.

"Everyone has them down as strong favourites

but I have been in many finals before where we have been favourites and we have not come out on top.

"That doesn't mean too much to me and I don't really care that everyone is bigging up the opposition."

Chelsea were hoping that midfield lynchpin Moises Caicedo would recover in time from a twisted ankle picked up in the semi-final victory over Fluminense on Tuesday.

Heat and huge prize money The match will be played

at the 82,500-capacity MetLife Stadium in New Jersey, with the Manhattan skyline as a backdrop. The home of NFL sides the New York Giants and New York Jets will also be the venue for the 2026 World Cup final.

It goes ahead at 3:00 pm local time (1900 GMT) amid ongoing concerns about the impact of high temperatures during the tournament, with Chelsea's Enzo Fernandez warning on Friday that playing in the middle of the afternoon was "very dangerous".

There are also concerns about the long-term impact on players of the match calendar -- the final will be the 65th game for PSG since their season began last August, and the 64th for Chelsea.

However, the financial rewards for all teams involved at the Club World Cup are enormous, and especially for the finalists.

Chelsea and PSG are assured to go home with over \$100 million in prize money, with the definitive amount to become clear after the final -- that money will be particularly welcome for Chelsea after they were recently fined by UEFA for breaching financial rules.

Infantino, meanwhile, was in buoyant mood as he spoke to media at Trump Tower in New York City on Saturday.

"We created something new, something which is here to stay, something which is changing the landscape of club football," he said of the 32-team tournament, the next edition of which is set to take place in 2029.

"It is already the most successful club competition in the world."

Rafael Nadal consoles shellshocked Amanda Anisimova after humiliating Wimbledon final defeat to Iga Swiatek



Amanda Anisimova looked shellshocked as she lost to Iga Swiatek in the Wimbledon 2025 women's singles final. It was rather a one-sided affair as Swiatek won 6-0, 6-0 in only 57 minutes, claiming her sixth Grand Slam title. The match also went down in history as only the second time Grand Slams that a final ended in a double bagel.

The first was in the 1988 French Open when Steffi Graf sealed a 6-0, 6-0 win against Natasha Zvereva.

It was also Anisimova's maiden Grand Slam final, but it proved to be a disappointing night. The American had beaten Aryna Sabalenka in the semi-finals, and will also be making her top-10 debut in the WTA Rankings.

Despite the one-sided defeat, Anisimova has received support from fans and former players, with Rafael Nadal joining the bandwagon. The Spaniard, who retired last year, took to X and wrote, "Be proud, @AnisimovaAmanda! Grand Slam finalist!"

Speaking to reporters after the final, the 23-year-old said, "When I got back to the locker room, I kind of had that switch in my mind of, 'You know what, this is probably going to make you stronger in the end.'"

"And to not really dig myself down or put myself down after today, and just try and focus on how I can come out stronger after this."

"I think it's honestly, like, a fork in the road. It's whatever direction you want to go in. I'm going to choose the path of working towards my goals and to try and keep improving, hopefully put myself in more positions and opportunities like today."

She also revealed that fatigue played a role in her defeat to Swiatek. "If anything, it's my physicality that I need to work on. To be able to last two weeks in a Grand Slam is definitely something that you need to work a lot on. It's not an easy feat," she said.

Klay Thompson relationship history: Who did NBA star date before Megan Thee Stallion?

dated comedian and influencer Hannah Stocking, but their relationship ended when Stocking accused Thompson of cheating. She made their split public, calling Thompson out on social media.

Carleen Henry (2015) – Thompson began dating stylist Carleen Henry shortly after breaking up with Stocking. Their relationship was not heavily publicized. However, their romance ended on an unpleasant note when private messages between them were leaked.

Other rumored romances – Thompson has been linked to various other women over the years, including Tiffany Suarez

(2015), Cherise Sandra (2016), Abigail Ratchford (2017), and Kristen Evangeline (2022). Most of these rumors, however, were never substantiated.

Meanwhile, amid Thompson's rumored romance with Stallion, the Dallas Mavericks guard's father Mychal Thompson said on a Mason & Ireland episode that he has "never heard of her before." Stallion made headlines after being shot in the foot by rapper Tory Lanez in July 2020.

In 2023, Lanez was sentenced to 10 years in prison for the shooting after being found guilty of all three charges prosecutors had brought against him – assault with a firearm, illegal possession of a firearm and negligent discharge of a gun for shooting the victim. During the sentencing, Lanez described the victim as his friend, saying she is "someone I still care for dearly to this day." Stallion did not appear in court for Lanez's sentencing, but said in a written statement, "For once, the defendant must be forced to face the full consequences of his heinous actions and face justice."

Lionel Messi bags vintage brace to extend record-breaking MLS streak: 'Breaking records every three days'

Lionel Messi's historic MLS continued on Saturday, as he scored twice in Inter Miami's 2-1 win over Nashville SC. The feat saw him extend his MLS record streak of multigoal games, which he claimed last week, when he became the first player in the league's history to score multiple goals in four straight games.

On Saturday, he took the tally to five, with a goal in each half. The result saw Miami move to fifth position in the Supporters' Shield leaderboard.

The 2022 World Cup winner opened the scoring with a stunning free-kick, beating the Nashville wall and goalkeeper Joe Willis, with a low left-footed shot, which went into the bottom corner. Then in the 62nd-minute, he intercepted a poor pass from Willis, and then took the ball around the goalkeeper with ease, and then slotted it into the net.

Speaking after the match, Miami head coach Javier Mascherano lavished praise on Messi and also spoke on his workload. "Obviously, we're monitoring the situation daily and having ongoing conversations with



him," he said.

"We'll find the right time to give him a break. What he continues to do is unbelievable - breaking records every three days. He's the flag bearer of this team, our leader, and he sets the standard for how we compete. It's truly a blessing to be part of this stage of his career."

It is also the first time Messi has scored in five straight multigoal league games, since his run of six with Barcelona in La Liga in 2012.

The Argentine's contract with Inter Miami is set to expire at the end of the calendar year. There have been reports about him wanting to sign an extension. MLS commissioner Don Garber

recently weighed in on Messi's contract situation.

Speaking to USA Today, he said, "Messi has been such an incredible part of the MLS story the last couple of years, and playing so well. It's just been a gift to have the best player in the world in Major League Soccer."

"We certainly look forward to him continuing his career in Miami. I know Jorge Mas and his partners are going to work hard to see if they're able to re-sign him and have him play here, hopefully prior to him playing for Argentina next summer."

And not anything more I can add on that, but I'm hopeful that we're able to re-sign him," he added.

Quinshon Judkins arrested: Advantage Jerome Ford? Exploring Browns' RB depth chart amid speculation

The reported arrest of Cleveland Browns rookie running back Quinshon Judkins on Saturday, for battery and domestic violence in Fort Lauderdale, has sparked speculation about the team's running back depth chart. The 21-year-old, No. 36 overall pick in the 2025 NFL Draft, is competing with Jerome Ford, who could gain a prominent role if Judkins misses games.

Judkins' Arrest and Potential Consequences Judkins was arrested and booked for "touch or strike/battery/domestic violence," according to NBC Sports.

The details remain limited, with the Fort Lauderdale Police Department and Browns "gathering information".

If found guilty, the rookie RB faces a likely six-game suspension under the NFL's Personal Conduct Policy, similar to teammate Mike Hall Jr.'s case in 2024. Placement on the Commissioner's Exempt List is possible, barring him from team activities during the investigation,



which could delay his season debut.

Impact on Browns' Depth Chart

Quinshon Judkins was projected as the Browns' RB1, expected to take over as the primary back after Nick Chubb's departure to the Houston Texans. The 21-year-old's college stats

(3,785 yards, 45 TDs at Ole Miss and Ohio State) and physicality (6'0", 221 lbs) make him a "workhorse" back. Pro Football Focus (PFF) predicts 1,093.8 rushing yards for him in 2025.

Jerome Ford was slated as RB3 or a change-of-pace back after a pay cut from

\$3.5 million to \$1.75 million, with Dylan Sampson as RB2.

However, the Saturday arrest could elevate Ford to RB1 or a larger role early in the season. Ford, in his final contract year, has proven capable, with 1,131 yards and 9 TDs in 2023 and 790 yards in 2024.

Dylan Sampson, a fourth-round pick with 1,491 yards and 22 TDs at Tennessee, could also see increased snaps, particularly in passing situations. Ahmani Marshall is also a key depth chart option.

Browns' Running Back Strategy

Cleveland, under Kevin Stefanski, aims to restore a run-heavy identity after a weak 2024 offense. Judkins and Sampson were drafted to complement a wide-zone scheme, but the former's absence could shift reliance to Ford's versatility and Sampson's speed.

Judkins is among 34 unsigned 2025 draft picks, with negotiations stalled over guaranteed money, potentially complicating his status.

"If We Kill Our Own Daughters...": WWE Legend The Great Khali Stunned By Radhika Yadav's Murder
