The inspection aimed to ensure that all Langars adhere to the highest standards of food safety and hygiene, thereby safeguarding the health of pil-

gratitude to the Union Minister for his prompt response and visit: "Your presence here today has truly won our hearts. We have always known you to be a positive and responsive leader, but I must admit-I did not expect such a swift and gracious response. A few days ago, during the NITI Aayog meeting, I had requested you to visit, especially after the Pahalgam incident, to reassure the people that the nation stands with us. He added that face-to-face engagement, as opposed to formal correspondence, helps in quicker resolution of issues. Earlier in the meeting, Principal Secretary, Agriculture Production Department, Shailendra Kumar, and Secretary, Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, Aijaz Asad, gave comprehensive presentations on the performance and progress of their respective departments. They highlighted implementation status, physical and financial achievements under various centrally sponsored schemes, GoI-supported and UT-specific schemes, including: PM-Kisan, RKVY, Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture; Rural infrastructure initiatives under MGNREGA, PMAY-G, NRLM, and PMAY

Key performance indicators, success stories from fieldlevel beneficiaries, and use of digital governance tools for real-time monitoring were also showcased.

The meeting broadly reviewed sectoral achievements, discussed bottlenecks, and chalked out action plans to accelerate progress in both Agriculture and Rural Development sectors.

On the occasion, in the presence of the Chief Minister and Union Agriculture Minister, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between Kudumbashree and JKRLM to establish 20 food service enterprises across all 20 districts of J&K. This initiative aims to empower women, Self-Help Groups (SHG) by creating local employment opportunities and building market-ready ventures. Additionally, the dignitaries launched 'Har Didi Ek Kahani'-a compendium of success stories of over 100 women SHGs who have become Lakhpati Didis through structured enterprise support, capacity building, and mentorship under the JKRLM framework. The Union Minister and the Chief Minister jointly made commitment for grassroots empowerment, inclusive growth, and stronger centrestate collaboration to transform the rural and agricultural ecosystem of Jammu and Kashmir.

On the occasion, a sensitisation meeting was also convened by the Joint Commissioner, in which Sachin Sharma, Additional Camp Director and representatives of Langars authorized to operate at the Base Camp Nunwan participated.It was informed that 12 Langars are currently operating at the Base Camp, Nunwan and 08 at the Transit Camp Chandanwari. During the meeting, State Nodal Officer FDA senzitized the representatives of the Langars on the importance of maintaining high standards of health hygiene and food safety. The Langar representatives and food handlers were emphasized for compliance with the Advisory issued by the department, focusing on key areas like sanitary and

hygienic requirements, proper storage conditions, regular checking of expiry dates of raw materials, use of potable water for food preparation, disposal of food waste, pest and rodent control measures, prohibition of un permitted food colors, ensuring health certificates for food handlers, registration of Langars under the Food Safety and Standards Act,

2006. The Joint Commissioner Food Safety said that the Food Safety Department is firmly committed to monitor and enforce the food safety standards during the Shri Amarnath Yatra. He urged Food Business Operators (FBOs) to strictly adhere to the guidelines and regulations, ensuring a safe and healthy experience for all the pilgrims.

Divisional Commissioner Kashmir Vijay Kumar Bidhuri, speaking to reporters at one of the camps, said, This Yatra is not just a religious pilgrimage. From security forces to pitthus, tents to service providers-everyone is contributing to its success. The enthusiasm among the devotees is unparalleled. I pray everyone's wishes are fulfilled and peace prevails across Kashmir and the country.' Pilgrims also expressed satisfaction with the arrangements. A devotee at the Pahalgam base camp said, "We are not afraid of terrorism. The facilities are excellent. We are thankful to the Shrine Board."A veteran pilgrim from Sangrur, Punjab, said, "This is my 14th Amarnath Yatra. The arrangements get better each time. There's no need to rush-everything is well-managed." To ensure the smooth conduct of the Yatra, a three-tier security grid has been implemented, with thousands of security personnel deployed along the route. In addition to conventional measures, AI-powered CCTV surveillance systems are monitoring key locations for real-time threat detection. Meanwhile, the second batch of 5,246 pilgrims left the Bhagwati Nagar base camp in Jammu on Thursday morning. The batch included 4,074 males, 795 females, 19 children, 324 sadhus, 33 sadhvis, and one transgender pilgrim. Of these, 1,993 pilgrims are headed to Baltal and 3,253 to Pahalgam. A fleet of 268 vehicles - including 106 buses, 38 medium motor vehicles (MMVs), and 124 light motor vehicles (LMVs) - has been deployed for transportation.On Wednesday, the first batch of 5,485 Yatris was flagged off from the Jammu base camp by Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha. Upon arrival in the Kashmir Valley, the pilgrims received a warm welcome from the Administration and locals. The Yatra, which began Thursday, will conclude on August 9.Pilgrims from across the country undertake the Amarnath Yatra to pay obeisance at the holy cave shrine that houses a naturally formed ice Shivlingam.
